

PE and Sports Grant 1 April 2016 - 31 March 2017

Schools can choose how they use the funding, for example to:

- hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers during PE lessons
- support and involve the least active children by running after/in-school sports activities
- provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers
- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation
- run sports activities with other schools
