Dear Nursery Parents,

We are all looking forward to our trip to Bocketts Farm on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July. There are a few organisational details to share with you:

Both Nursery classes will be spending the day together. Please bring your child (or children) to school (Nursery entrance) at 8:45 a.m. on Tuesday morning, even if your child normally attends the afternoon session; the coach will leave promptly at 9.00am. We plan to be back at school in time for the normal end of the day at 3:20-3:30 p.m. If there is any delay, you will be contacted directly by the office staff via text message.

Please equip your child or children with the following for the trip:

- Uniform - leggings or shorts and t-shirts - no dresses, please (there is a playground with climbing frames, etc. at Bocketts). Sweatshirt or cardigan. If the weather turns, we will take with us the raincoats and wellies that are kept at school.
- Shoes - closed-toe shoes or trainers - no open-toed sandals - Velcro fastening if possible.
- A packed lunch in a lunch box or small backpack. We are encouraged to bring our litter home with us from the farm. Try to include foods your child will eat willingly, in wrappings that are easy to undo. No nuts or products containing nuts (pesto, muesli bars, etc.).
- A filled water bottle.
- A hat. No sunglasses, thank you.

Please write your child's name on everything you send for the trip.

**Apply sunscreen before bringing your child or children to school on Tuesday morning.**

If travel sickness is a problem, please speak to a member of staff by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July so that we can plan ahead to help your child have a comfortable journey.

If there is any possibility of your child having a toilet accident during the trip, please supply a change of clothes. We will do our best to help them discreetly.

Bocketts Farm is a very well organised destination for school trips. The staff deliver an exciting and informative program and our children will have a lot of fun. We will take lots of photos and post them on Tapestry as soon as we can.
