

Year 1 – Autumn Term



<p>In English, we will be...</p> <p>Phonics: Children in Year 1 will revise the sounds they learnt in Reception and continue to use to blend (Read) and segment (Spell) words. We will be learning new sounds each week from phases 3, 4 and 5 as well as reading and writing tricky words (words you cannot sound out) from these phases.</p> <p>Reading: We will be reading a range of Fiction, Non-Fiction and poetry from around the world as a class. If you have any at home, please feel free to bring them in. Children will be learning a range of reading strategies to support their comprehension and decoding skills.</p> <p>Writing: Children will continue/begin to write simple sentences, thinking about adjectives and punctuation. They will be encouraged to write using cursive script and to use their sounds to sound it out.</p> <p>The children will start to have a spelling test every Friday. We would recommend you practise these with your child every day. Please start using the words in sentences so the children can apply these spellings in their writing.</p> <p><u>Reading books</u> continue to be changed regularly. Guided reading will continue to happen with every child. It is still important that your children are reading a range of genres at home including stories, non-fiction and poetry. <u>Please continue to use our Phonics Bug online.</u></p>	<p>In Science we will be learning ...</p> <p>This term the children will be: Identifying and naming a variety of common animals; naming and describing animal and human body parts; identifying and naming wild and garden plants; identifying and naming parts of a plant.</p>	<p>In Maths we will be learning...</p> <p>Place Value: The children will be counting to 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. They will be counting, reading and writing numbers to 20 in numerals and words. They will be given a number to identify one more and less. They will use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most and least.</p> <p>Number: The children will represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10. They will read, write and interpret number sentences involving addition, subtraction and equals signs. They will add and subtract 1 digit numbers to 10, including 0. They will also be solving one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using objects, pictures and missing number problems.</p> <p>Shape: Children will learn to recognise, name and describe simple 2D and 3D shapes and sort them according to their properties.</p> <p><u>Please look out for Abacus Games every week</u>, which will help support their learning.</p>
<p>In Geography and History we will be learning...</p> <p>We will be naming and locating the world's 7 continents using maps and atlases. This will also be supported by our Woodpecker and Chaffinch Geography News Book.</p>	<p>In RE we will be learning ...</p> <p>These are our topics for the term: What responsibility has God given people for taking care of creation; why are Saints important to Christianity; which Nativity character are you? Why are you important?</p>	<p>In Music we will be...</p> <p>These are our topics for the term: Listening and responding to music about animals; creating own improvised birdsong composition using percussion instruments; performing with an increasingly secure sense of pulse.</p>
<p>In Art and DT we will be...</p> <p>We will be exploring and creating collages and experimenting with water colours which will help us to create a sunset painting.</p>	<p>In ICT we will be ...</p> <p>We will be learning to save and retrieve our own learning and create an Online Safety poster.</p> <p>Later in the term we will design and make Christmas cards (choosing their own programme).</p>	<p>Dear Parents, A big warm welcome to Year One!
