This is not meant to be an extra expense, please use what you have at home or borrow if you can. If you are finding this difficult, please let your child's teacher know. If your child is in Saint Andrew's house they can wear their blue school P.E T-shirt.

For sports day only, we ask that all children come to school wearing their sports kit; blue shorts, plimsolls/trainers and a T- shirt in the colour of their house (red, yellow, blue or green). The children should bring their school uniform in a named bag so they can get changed afterwards.

Please remember to apply plenty of sun screen to your child before school and to pack their water bottle and school summer hat on the day as it can sometimes be very warm and there is little shelter.

In the interests of the safety of your children and mindful of the fact that Mill Lane is now open parkland, please do not walk across the track to speak with your child. As they are sat in houses, not all the staff will be able to identify you.
