Year 2 visit to Littlehampton

In order to support our learning in Geography, English, Science and Art, we are organising a visit to Littlehampton on Wednesday 14th June 2017. We will be travelling by coach and we plan to leave the school at 9.00 am and return by 3.30 pm. Your child will need a packed lunch in a rucksack (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal and you would like a school packed lunch, please let the office know by 5th June 2017. **Please bring a waterproof jacket in case of rain.**

We would like to build sandcastles, so if your child has a small bucket and spade they are welcome to bring them along, as long as they are named. We will also be giving the children the chance to paddle in the sea (only a few at a time and when holding an adult's hand), so please send your child in with a small towel. Girls may wish to wear a pair of shorts under their school dress for paddling.

I am very keen for this visit to take place. However, under the terms of the 1988 Education Reform Act, we are unable to charge for educational visits which take place in school hours and can only ask for voluntary contributions. I should point out that no funds are available to pay for a child whose parents are unwilling or unable to make the contribution but no child will be excluded from this event on such grounds. However, if insufficient contributions are received to cover the cost of the visit we shall be unable to go. Assuming that all parents are willing to contribute, the cost per pupil will be £11.53 payable via ParentPay. If you have any difficulties in affording this amount please make an appointment to see Mrs Hart Dyke privately.

If you are willing to volunteer as an adult helper for this visit please let us know.
