Our Dramabuds club is devised exclusively for children in school years 1 – 3. Our carefully crafted story adventures are planned to excite, engage and enthrall the children. Our classes create a positive fun environment for children to naturally grow and blossom in confidence. Whilst our stories ignite young imaginations, helping children to become creative thinkers, to problem solve and write creatively at school, Dramabuds also helps develop speaking, listening and communication skills raising self-esteem and gently encouraging children to excel.

This summer term we will bringing to life Rudyard Kipling's classic tale: The Jungle Book.

We join a young boy called Mowgli in the jungle at moonlight. Akela the wise old wolf leads the jungle pack and finds Mowgli a home with the loving wolves. Mowgli learns the many languages of the jungle with his teacher Baloo the bear and meets Bagheera the black panther who protects Mowgli from Shere Khan; the dangerous tiger. Bandar-log the monkey people lead Mowgli to mischief, and all the jungle animals must work together to help bring Mowgli to safety. The term will be filled with drama, our original Dramabuds: Mowgli and Shere Kahn songs and an enchanting fire dance.

Our term finishes with an enchanting show on the 13th July (more details nearer the time).
