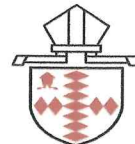

Games will be 5 minutes each way – each team to play the others once in a league of 4 teams (3 games for each team and 6 games in all) Due to time constraints, teams need to change straight round at half time - team talks to be given between games rather than at half time.

COMPETITION RULES

1. The winning school at the Finals Evening will be declared Sutton Champions and will go forward to represent Sutton in the Surrey County Round at Woking in January. There will be a winners and runners up trophy awarded to the tournament finalists.
2. Games will consist of two periods of 5 minutes with teams changing straight round at half time. Normal F.A. Laws shall apply except that there will be no offside.
3. Each squad shall consist of a maximum of 9 players. Two substitutes are allowed at any time. A substituted player may return to the field of play. Boys and Girls in Y6 or Y5 are eligible to play.
4. In the league section a win shall gain 3 points and a draw 1 point. Should teams share first position on points, the position shall be decided on goal difference. Should points and goal difference be equal, the winners shall be the team scoring most goals. If this fails to determine the winning team, the position shall be decided by penalty kicks
5. Penalty Kicks - Three penalty takers to be nominated by each team from their squad of nine. Three kicks to be taken alternately by each team. If, after 3 penalty kicks each, the teams are still level, kicks shall proceed alternately by other squad members on a sudden death basis.
6. In accordance with English Schools' regulations, year 6 and 5 boys and girls are allowed to take part in this National Competition but no children under 9 years of age at the beginning of this season - midnight August 31st/September 1st 2017.
