Textile Club is devoted to designing and making things from fabric and thread. The club is led by Mrs Bangs, who teaches in Foundation Stage. We meet after school on Tuesdays until 4.30 p.m. and will begin on 20<sup>th</sup> September.

In Textile Club, we begin by investigating Colour Theory, and put theory into practice by making a needle-case to keep. This first project also teaches – or revises - basic sewing skills and simple embroidery stitches. Once the needle-cases are finished, we work on a variety of projects, such as dyeing or printing fabric, and make small items such as Christmas decorations or notebook covers.

If a large number of children wish to join, it may be necessary to split into groups who each have a spell in the club, so everyone has a chance to participate.
