

Spelling Activities

Each week you need to complete an activity from List 1 on your spelling home learning sheet. Please also complete an activity from List 2 and write on your spelling sheet the activity you chose and have a parent sign to say that you completed it. Should you wish to add any photographs you can!

List 1

1. **Rainbow Words**- Write your words and trace over them in 3 different colours.
2. **Ransom Words**- Cut letters out of newspaper, magazines, or write them out on paper and cut them, then glue them together to build your words.
3. **Hidden Words**- Write your words and find hidden words in your words. Ex. that - hat - at
4. **Word Search**- Create a word search. Find your words.
5. **Word Hunt**- Search for your words in newspapers or around the house on packets or leaflets. If you can cut them out and stick them on the sheet.
6. **Font-abulous**- Type your words in 3 different fonts on the computer. Print them and stick them on your sheet.
7. **3 Way Words**- Write your words three ways, really big, really small, and in your best handwriting.
8. **Word Boxes**- Write your words. Then make boxes around each phoneme.
9. **Trace & Spell**- Have someone write your words neatly. Trace the words spelling out each letter in the word.
10. **Spelling Sentences**- Write each word in a sentence.
11. **Creative Writing** - Use your spelling words in a story, letter, diary entry, recount or non-chronological report.
12. **ABC Order**- Write your words in alphabetical order 3 times.
13. **Silly Riddle Words**- Write a riddle for each of your words. Include a clue about how the word is spelled. Solve your riddles.
Ex. The word is 4 letters long. The first letter is b and it rhymes with shark.
14. **Crossword Puzzle**- Create a crossword puzzle on puzzlemaker.com. Solve it.
15. **Word Strategies**- Come up with a strategy to help you learn each of your “tricky words”.
Ex. B-E-A-U-tiful or a mnemonic Ex. **Big Elephant Can Add Up Sums Easily**.
16. **Syllable Spelling**- Write your words breaking them up into syllables

List 2

1. **Spell & Brush**- Spell your words while brushing & flossing your teeth.
2. **Spell & Play**- Spell your words while playing an instrument.
3. **Cheer & Spell**- Cheer the spelling of your word. ‘Give me a b, give me an a, give me a g. What have you got? Bag’
4. **Body Letters**- Spell each of your words while making each letter with your body
5. **Word Exercise**- Spell your words while doing your favourite exercise
6. **Travel Spelling**- Spell your words out loud in the car, while riding your bike, or while taking a walk
7. **Sing & Spell**- Sing a song or chant your spelling words. Ex. Peo-ple, peo-ple
8. **Record & Spell**- Tape record yourself spelling your spelling words. Play the tape again and spell along.
9. **Magnetic Letters**- If you have magnetic letters, use them to build your spelling words.
10. **Artistic Spelling** - Paint or draw a picture containing as many of your spelling words as possible.
11. **Commercial break** - Create a 45 second television advert for a product of your choice where you say as many of your spellings as you can.
