


All Saints Carshalton Church of England Primary School is situated on the corner of two residential roads (Talbot Road and Ruskin Road).





Why Cycle or scooter?



Children who cycle to school are significantly fitter than children who travel by any other modes. We believe that cycling is a life skill that everyone should benefit from.

Why Walk?



Walking helps our children develop road safety skills which will keep them safe in later life. Active children are more likely to become active adults. Walking helps keep our local air clean, and our local streets free from congestion.

Park and stride?



Park away from school (near Carshalton Park is a good place) and walk the final 5–10 minutes to school.

Other modes of transport

Rail



Carshalton and Carshalton Beeches stations are a ten minute walk away from our school. Trains run from here to Victoria, Sutton, Epsom and West Croydon and London Bridge via Norwood Junction.

Bus



The 407 bus from Caterham runs along Carshalton High Street to Sutton town centre.
