'Hello, my name is Jacqui Morrissey and I was elected as a parent Governor in April 2016. I have two boys in the school, currently in year 2 and year 4, both of whom enjoy being in a friendly, lively school, and I'm constantly challenged by trying to remember the various things going on (even though they're always in this newsletter)!



I feel very privileged to be a parent governor, elected by you, and take this responsibility seriously. There are several sub-committees of the full governing board which meet termly to look in more detail at specific areas of the school. I'm chair of the School Community Committee, a member of the Finance, Personnel and Premises Committee and have also volunteered to be part of the newly established Curriculum and Standards Committee. This new Committee will meet for the first time on Thursday 18th January and will be focusing on pupil performance. As a governor, this means taking a step back and looking at the trends in performance in reading, writing and maths for all year groups, working with Mr Marston and Mrs Hart Dyke to ensure the school is doing everything it can to help every child achieve their full potential. 
Medicines - Please note we are not able to administer any medication that hasn't been prescribed by the doctor. We ask that parents keep a note of the expiry date of all medication brought into school.
