Meet our Governors



My name is Steve Mendat. I am the school premises manager. I have been involved with the school since 1988. My daughter Rebecca, attended here and I became an active member of the PTA.

In April 2016, I became staff Governor and also a member of the School Community Committee. Since joining the Governing Body, I have become a link governor for Computing and along with fellow governors; Mr. Peter Smith and Mr. Matt Zunde-Baker, we met with Mr. Musson, our Computing Subject Leader and discussed how the children learn about this area of the curriculum. The children in Chaffinch Class with Miss Morgan's help, demonstrated how they use small robots called 'Beebots' to create simple coding.

Transfer to Secondary School - September 2018 (current Year 5)

A meeting has been organised for parents of children in Year 5 regarding the transfer to secondary school process on Friday 23 June at 8.45am. It should last approximately 30 minutes and will take place in the hall.

Lunch Boxes



Parents will be aware that we have several children in school who have a severe allergic reaction to nuts. For this reason may I remind parents of children having a packed lunch not to include nuts of any kind in their child's lunch box? This includes pine nuts, e.g. in pesto sauce.

We have also found several chocolate bars in lunch boxes recently. Please could I ask that no chocolate or sweets of any kind are included in children's packed lunches? Chocolate is not used in the preparation of any school meals; cocoa is used instead. Thank you for your help with this matter.

Please could I ask parents not to wait in the car park for clubs running after school? It is still in use by staff and I would hate it if there were an accident, either from a child being hurt or a car being damaged accidentally.
